

As part of your membership with CAPT, you have access to all the **International Journal** to Play Therapy (IJPT) for over 25 years. These articles are peer reviewed so they are the best of the best. Here are some of the latest and greatest. Enjoy.

**Online Access to APA journals:** If you are not a member of the American Psychological Association or do not have a current account with the APA, go to [my.apa.org](http://my.apa.org) and click on "Create an Account" and enter the email address you used to sign up with CAPT as your user name and create a password.

The password will need to be 8-14 characters long, with a mix of letters, numbers or symbols. If you are a member of the American Psychological Association or if you already have an established login account with the APA, go to [my.apa.org](http://my.apa.org) and login with your current user name and password. Once you're logged on, scroll down to the area designated as "Subscriptions."

**Under Subscriptions scroll down to the section "Journals," where your journal is listed, then click on your journal to view it.**

From here you can view the citation and full text of any article published in the journal. Please note that you will be able to browse all of the journals in APA's PsycARTICLES database; however, you will have access to the full text of only those to which you subscribe.
