Deadline for Submission: January 20, 2023

PURPOSE: The mission of CAPTTM is to promote the value of play, play therapy and Certified Play Therapists in Canada.

CAPT[™] will award one research grant of \$500 to a project involving current research in the area of play and play therapy for 2022. The Award is approved by an Ethics Board.

Applications must be received by CAPTTM no later than January 20, 2023 and the study or a report of the study is to be completed and submitted by October 1, 2023.

A decision regarding grant applications will be made by the Research Committee by February 28, 2023.
